- Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in parking authorities, further 2 providing for special provisions for authorities in cities of 3 the first class. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 5508.1(a), (b), (c) and (d) of Title 53 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and the 8 section is amended by adding a subsection to read: 10 § 5508.1. Special provisions for authorities in cities of the 11 first class. Scope. -- This section applies only to cities of the 12 <--13 first class. Initial. -- Beginning on the effective date of this 14 <--15 chapter, the powers of each authority shall be exercised by a 16 board composed of not less than five nor more than 11 members.
- 17 (c) Subsequent.--Beginning June 1, 2006, the board shall be
- 18 composed of six members.

- 1 (d) Residence. -- In all cases, board members must be
- 2 residents of the city.]
- 3 (d.1) Board structure. -- The powers of an authority in a city
- 4 of the first class shall be exercised by a board composed of six
- 5 members. The majority of the members must be residents of the
- 6 city of the first class. Each member must be a resident of the
- 7 county in which the city of the first class is located or work
- 8 or maintain a business in the city of the first class.

- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
